##### **Goal**

The Todd Hall Benchmark Reading Assessments (CBM) will be administered to all students in grades K, 1 and 2 to determine current skill levels. Specific, measurable outcomes will be written for all students not meeting district grade level benchmarks. The CBMs will be administered again in the Winter and Spring of 2008.

##### **STRATEGIES/ACTIVITIES**

1. Refine curriculum-based measurements for reading.
2. Administer CBMs in grades K, 1 and 2.
3. Analyze CBM results identify students meeting/not meeting benchmark standards.
4. Set specific goals for students not meeting benchmarks, implement & monitor instructional plan.
5. Continue cycle of assessing, reviewing/revising goals and instructional plans for students not meeting benchmarks.
6. Utilize a data warehouse system (AimsWeb) to store and interpret assessment data.
7. Provide staff development on CBM administration, scoring, data analysis, student goal setting & instructional/intervention plan development.
8. Provide parents with information about reading instruction, at-home reading, student progress, and standards-based report cards.
