

- 2023 Location: Lincoln Hall Middle School, 6855 North Crawford, Lincolnwood, IL 60712 (Student drop-off in front of Rutledge Hall School.)
- Parents are responsible for transportation to and from SD74 Summer Adventures. No buses will be provided.
- Students are enrolled in classes based on their grade levels for the 2023-24 school year.
- Program is open to all students entering Kindergarten through 8th grade. Lincolnwood School District 74 families' registration starts Friday, March 3, 2023, and then opens to out of district families on Friday, March 10, 2023. REGISTER EARLY! Registration is based on a first-come, first-served basis.
- Each class is 50 minutes long. Students may enroll in up to four (4) sessions.
- Tuition is **\$90 per class**. Credit, debit or e-check are accepted online.
- Families have until June 22, 2023 to withdraw from SD74 Summer Adventures to receive a full refund. After June 22, 2023, tuition is non-refundable.
- There are no refunds for natural disasters or inclement weather that may interfere with the operation of SD74 Summer Adventures classes.
