Rescue Rangers

In an attempt to help seniors with snow shoveling and other routine tasks like bringing the garbage totes out to the curb and returning them to the resident's side yards, the Village created the Rescue Rangers program.

Rescue Rangers is designed to help seniors with managing the life tasks which may be too strenuous for them. The Rescue Rangers are allowed to charge a fee of \$10 per hour for their services. **Note:** If a student is participating in the Rescue Rangers program to log community service hours for Lincoln Hall, the student will not be compensated for their service(s).

Rescue Rangers mainly consist of 7th and 8th grade students. Each participant will receive a ski cap that allows senior residents to recognize the students as part of our Rescue Rangers program.

Since most students in the program are in middle school and do not have access to a car, we try to keep your assignment to folks who live within walking distance from the senior's home.

Rescue Rangers who serve in the program are provided with a letter of recommendation written by the Mayor which can be used for college or job aspirations.

What are the program's objectives?

- To help senior residents who are unable to complete daily living tasks.
- To develop a greater sense of community by creating a sense that the Village can take the lead in solving real life problems.
- To help youth demonstrate leadership and problem solving.
- To build loyalty and a stronger sense of friendship among neighbors for a job well done.
